# From the desk of the Parish Priest.....Father Declan

As a Parish Pastoral Council we are currently reading a book entitled "Partnership in Parish (A Vision for parish life, mission and ministry)" by Irish theologian, Father Enda Lyons. So far we have read the first two chapters. So why are the Pastoral Council doing this? and what do we hope to achieve by our reading and reflection? As a Council we are reading this book in an effort to form ourselves and come to some understanding of what the Church is and what a parish is? In coming to such an understanding we will be and should be in a better and more enlightened position to name and claim what is Saint Mary's and what is our vision for the future. The one thing I have re-learned and a point that Lyons is keen to stress is that the Church, the parish, any parish; not just Saint Mary's is all about people! The Church, The Parish gather as a group of people because we seek each other out as a people who have a common interest; Our common interest is of course the Good News of Jesus Christ which is essentially God's all consuming- unconditional love for all of us. All the other "Church structures" we have only exist to serve our common interest.

One of those "Structures", is of course the church building! This weekend our rebuilding plans are on view here in the Parish and two members of our Parish Finance group, Jim Houlahan and Paul Gubbels, will talk to us about these and what our path forward is. As a parish, as the local church of Saint Mary's we go forward, mindful of our past, alive to the Holy Spirit in the present, and journey on to a hope-filled future.
