Transfiguration Sunday
(August 5th and 6th, 2017)

This Sunday we celebrate the feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord. At this event on Mount Tabor Jesus let his true identity be revealed. He was seen in all his Glory. What is that glory? The face of God who sustains and is our all powerful Creator, whose name is Love and Mercy.

Eucharist as meal (Part 3)

Jesus used meals to talk about God mercy and compassion. The three parable of mercy in Luke 15 immediately follow the complaint by those learned men of the Law, that "this man welcomes sinners and eats with them!". Jesus often healed and forgive sins and spoke of the quality of God's love at meals. He used these occasions to do whatever was necessary to reconcile people with God.

At the last Supper, the meal directly related to the Eucharist, bread and wine were reminders of joy and plenty in the promised land. These signs of God's bounty and protection; of his willingness and eagerness to deliver his people. Those who shared the bread and wine received a personal share in the blessing that was spoken. Jesus focused the meaning of the sharing even more sharply by stating that the bread was his body and the wine his blood; the true blood of the new and everlasting covenant promised by Jeremiah (31; 31-34).
